The City of Macon clean-up day will be May 8th from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm at the South Macon Township parking lot, located at 110 N. Wall Street. We are unable to accept electronics, paint, or appliances. If you are 65 years of age or older, workers will be happy to assist you and pick up your refuse. To make arrangements for pick up, call Pam at City Hall **by May 7th**. She can be reached at 217-764-3643. The city has received complaints about residents accumulating debris on their property. Please take advantage of clean-up and help make Macon beautiful! This will be the only clean-up day for the year 2021.

Disposal Service

Per city ordinance, disposal service is required in Macon. Anyone in arrears will receive an ordinance violation in the amount of \$75. United Waste will be collecting recycling on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of every month. If you would like a recycling tote, call United Waste Services at 217-425-4011.

Water Bills

Water bills are due by the 10th of every month. If you pay **after** the 10th, there will be a \$10 late fee added to your bill. Late notices are sent out on the 11th or the first business day after the 10th. If you do not pay your bill **before** the shut-off date stated on the late notice, your water will be turned off and you will have to pay a \$50 reconnect fee. Water bills can be paid at the community center, by mail, or by drop box (one located at the community center and one located at the water tower on Front Street). Payments can also be made online at the city's website, www.maconcity.us or by ACH. (The ACH form can be accessed on the website or one can be requested from the water department office located at the community center.)
